1 Contract to Host the 75th International Astronautical Congress Signed

AIDAA and the International Astronautical Federation (IAF) signed the IAC2024 contract on 15th July 2022 in Milan. The ceremony was held at Palazzo Lombardia with the presence of Pascale Ehrenfreund, President of the IAF; Attilio Fontana, President of the Lombardy Region; Elena Buscemi, President of Milan City Council; Erasmo Carrera, President of AIDAA; Giorgio Saccoccia, President of ASI; Alessandro Profumo, CEO of Leonardo; and Christian Feichtinger, IAF Executive Director.

5 4th Edition of "Franco Persiani" Degree Award

AIDAA announces the opening of the call for application of the 4th edition of the Degree Award in memory of Professor Franco Persiani. AIDAA promotes the award together with "Centro Studi Franco Persiani" and Ser.In.Ar. The award is intended for graduate students in Aerospace Engineering at any Italian university who have discussed their master's thesis on the subject of 'Innovation for the aeronautical sector' in the period between 1 October 2020 and 30 September 2022.

The award will be assigned by the Selection Committee (composed of Professors Luca Piancastelli, Erasmo Carrera, Leonardo Lecce, Caterina Grillo and Francesco Marulo), based on the criteria of innovation, scientific rigour and applied methodology, the quality and clarity of the paper and the grade. Candidates wishing to apply must submit an application by 30 September (downloadable at www.serin ar.unibo.it), directly to the Ser.In.Ar offices in Cesena (via Uberti, 48 from 9 a.m. to 12 noon) or by registered mail with acknowledgement of receipt or by certified email to serinar@legalmail.it.
